For pregnant women and their babies

Electronic breast pump – Enrolled pregnant members are eligible for an electronic breast pump (limit 1).

Healthy First Steps® – We'll work with you and your primary care provider (PCP) to help you have the best pregnancy experience possible and take healthy steps along the way.

Babyscripts – The Babyscripts program rewards you for going to your prenatal and postpartum visits. Download the Babyscripts myJourney app.

Mom's Meals – Pregnant members can receive 30 meals (2 meals for 15 days) post-delivery ordered to their house.



Help with complex conditions

Care Management – Extra support for those with chronic conditions and complex needs, or anyone who has trouble finding care.²

Care coordination – We can help schedule appointments and keep all your providers informed about the care you're getting.²

Asthma support (Hypoallergenic Assistance Program) – Members who are enrolled in care management may qualify for a hypoallergenic mattress cover and pillowcase.



Support for you

Peer support specialists – Coaches can provide support for substance use disorder (SUD) recovery.

Community resources – We can connect you with local programs and services, including those for housing, food and job training.*

Wellhop for Mom and Baby App – A program where pregnant women meet in groups online. You'll get helpful information and tips. You'll also connect with other moms.
