Attendant Care – is a combination of services which may include homemaking, personal care, and general supervision to assist you to meet your daily needs and allow you to live in your own home.

Durable Medical Equipment (DME) – is certain medical equipment that is ordered by your doctor for use at home. DME includes, but is not limited to: wheelchairs, crutches, hospital bed, IV infusion pump, oxygen equipment, nebulizer, and walker.

Emergency Alert – is a monitoring system which will call for assistance if you are unable to get assistance in an emergency situation and/or live alone.

Home Delivered Meals – is a service for members who reside in their own home, but who may not be able to prepare enough nutritious food to maintain good health

Non-Emergency Medical Transportation – is medically necessary transportation to and from your medical appointments, using sedan, wheelchair and stretcher services. Non-Emergency Medical Transportation does not replace emergency ambulance services, and certain restrictions may apply; please contact the health plan

Vision Services – provides **v**ision exams and glasses for children under age 21; certain restriction apply for adult members, please contact the health plan.
